APO Membership Contributions for 2024

At the 63rd Session of the APO Governing Body (GBM) held on 8 and 9 June 2021, the Directors decided that the total APO membership contribution for the 2023–24 biennium would remain the same as previously at USD11,986,035. The formula for apportioning this amount was also unchanged. Based on the agreed total amount and continuing formula, the applicable amount for each member country's contribution for FY2024 has been computed and is shown in the attached table as confirmed by the 64th GBM held on 7 and 8 June 2022.
