Overview:

In a one-day workshop participants from government, academia, care associations, care industries and civil society will explore best practices in care giving, develop qualifications framework and career pathways to high-productivity industries, identify curriculum content and strategies as well as recommend legal frameworks for professionalization.

Outcomes:

- Creation of a Qualification's Framework and career pathways for caregivers.
- Curriculum outline and content for caregiver training programs.
- Amended or new regulatory frameworks to assure quality and ensure high standards of care provision.
- Strategies and action recommendations to improve access to quality and affordable caregiving for middle-income and vulnerable groups.

Better policy-making related to care, ease regulatory burdens, attract investment, promote the development of caregiving education and training programmes based on quality standards, retention of women in workforce and job creation.
