TUJUAN & LATAR BELAKANG Keterangan: Tujuan dan penerangan ringkas mengenai projek	i) Following the Cabinet decision on 20 January 2025, the European Union (EU) and Malaysia announced the resumption of negotiations for a comprehensive and modern Free Trade Agreement (FTA). The Ministry of Investment, Trade, and Industry (MITI) has been appointed as the national coordinator, with the Malaysia Productivity Corporation (MPC) designated as the Lead Negotiator for the Good Regulatory Practice (GRP) chapter. (Appendix 1) ii) As part of capacity building and knowledge exchange for regulatory reform programs, the Malaysian delegation will leverage this opportunity to organize a bilateral meeting and benchmarking sessions with the European Commission and the Federal Public Service Policy and Support (FPS BOSA). The objective of this engagement is to exchange best practices and perspectives on regulatory reform. The detailed itinerary is provided in Appendix 2. iii) The delegation will comprise two representatives from MPC as GRP chapter leads and one representative from the Attorney General's Chambers (AGC) as legal advisor.
JUSTIFIKASI Keterangan: Penjelasan yang menyokong kepada pelaksanaan projek/ cadangan	1. Regulatory provisions have gained prominence in recent regional trade agreements (RTAs), reflecting their growing importance. MPC plays a pivotal role as the lead regulatory oversight body responsible for implementing the National Policy on Good Regulatory Practice (NPGRP). The GRP chapter under the Malaysia-EU FTA (MEUFTA) is crucial for MPC to position its function and protect Malaysia's sovereignty. 2. Successful conclusion of the GRP chapter, aligned with Malaysia's readiness to implement GRP principles, will

	create an enabling regulatory environment that supports sustainable economic growth and fosters mutually beneficial trade relations among participating countries. 3. To enhance capacity building and facilitate knowledge exchange on regulatory reform programs, the Malaysian delegation will conduct benchmarking sessions exclusively with the European Commission and the Federal Public Service Policy and Support (FPS BOSA). This engagement will allow for detailed discussions with key counterparts responsible for regulatory policy and implementation. 4. The primary objective is to foster a collaborative learning environment to share best practices and perspectives between Malaysia and these European institutions. This collaboration will help strengthen Malaysia's regulatory frameworks and improve approaches to regulatory reform.
