TUJUAN & LATAR BELAKANG Keterangan: Tujuan dan penerangan ringkas mengenai projek	i) The Government Service Efficiency Commitment Act 2025 (Act 867) has been gazetted on 22 Mei 2025 (not yet in force) aims to enhance the quality, efficiency, and effectiveness of government services by reducing bureaucracy, minimizing regulatory burdens, and implementing service performance ratings for government entities. ii) Following the Cabinet decision on 20 January 2025, the European Union (EU) and Malaysia announced the resumption of negotiations for a comprehensive and modern Free Trade Agreement (FTA). The Ministry of Investment, Trade, and Industry (MITI) has been appointed as the national coordinator, with the Malaysia Productivity Corporation (MPC) designated as the Lead Negotiator for the Good Regulatory Practice (GRP) chapter. (Appendix 1) iii) In conjunction with MEUFTA bilateral meeting and as part of GRP technical knowledge exchange for regulatory reform programs, the Malaysian delegation will leverage this opportunity to organize Regulatory Cooperation Dialogue with the the European Commission; FPS BOSA, Belgium; Department for Business & Trade, UK; and Blavatnik School of Government, University of Oxford and participating in MEUFTA bilateral meeting. The objective of this engagement is to exchange best practices and perspectives on regulatory reform. The detailed program is provided in Appendix 2. iv) The delegation will comprise of 7 officers from:

JUSTIFIKASI Keterangan: Penjelasan yang menyokong kepada pelaksanaan projek/ cadangan	1. The Malaysia Productivity Corporation (MPC) must support the implementation of the Government Service Efficiency Commitment Act 2025 by providing technical expertise, tools, and training aligned with the National Policy on Good Regulatory Practice (GRP), including regulatory impact analysis and strategies for reducing regulatory burdens. This alignment ensures that government service reforms are transparent, accountable, and performance-driven, consistent with GRP principles and national productivity objectives. 2. The Malaysian delegation will conduct regulatory cooperation dialogues with the European Commission; FPS BOSA, Belgium; Department for Business & Trade, UK; and Blavatnik School of Government, University of Oxford to facilitate capacity building, knowledge exchange, and engagement with key counterparts responsible for regulatory policy and implementation. These sessions aim to foster a collaborative learning environment that supports the sharing of best practices and strengthens Malaysia's regulatory frameworks and reform strategies. 3. Regulatory provisions have gained increasing prominence in recent regional trade agreements (RTAs), underscoring their strategic significance. As the lead regulatory oversight body implementing the National Policy on Good Regulatory Practice (NPGRP), MPC plays a pivotal role particularly under the GRP chapter of the Malaysia-EU Free Trade Agreement (MEUFTA) in asserting its regulatory leadership and safeguarding Malaysia's sovereignty.

Regulatory cooperation dialogues with the above institutions will foster international collaboration, leading to the adoption of best practices, improved policy formulation, and capacity building in Malaysia's regulatory institutions. 4. MPC's leadership in regulatory oversight, particularly under regional trade frameworks like the <i>Malaysia-EU Free Trade Agreement (MEUFTA)</i>, will reinforce its position as a guardian of national regulatory sovereignty and a key player in advancing GRP compliance across sectors.
