## About Green Mobility Innovation Summit

The Green Mobility Innovation Summit is part of a broader initiative under the BIMP- EAGA (Brunei Darussalam - Indonesia - Malaysia - Philippines East ASEAN Growth Area) Vision 2025 framework, which aims to enhance sustainable transportation and promote green economy in the region. The Vision 2025 plan emphasizes the importance of integrating green approaches into infrastructure development, climate resilience, and smart city initiatives.

The summit is aligned with BIMP-EAGA's on-going efforts to foster economic growth while prioritizing environmental sustainability, as reflected in their strategic frameworks and joint statements.

The Green Mobility Innovation Summit: *Driving the Future - Talent, Innovation & Sustainability in Green Mobility* is scheduled to take place on September 8 and 9, 2025, at the Imperial Hotel in Kuching, Sarawak, Malaysia. The event will host over 30 speakers and panellists from around the world, sharing insights on a range of topics aimed at driving positive change.
