Rules and regulations have to be in synchronisation with marketplace dynamics so as not to adversely affect business competitiveness. A more comprehensive regulatory reform approach is needed to give equal emphasis on promoting the entrepreneurial spirit, encouraging orderly transformation and protecting the welfare of the community. Towards this end, the reformation must address the quality of both new and existing regulations.
