TUJUAN & LATAR BELAKANG Keterangan: Tujuan dan penerangan ringkas mengenai projek	i) The ASEAN-OECD Good Regulatory Practices Network (GRPN) was established in 2014 as part of the OECD-Southeast Asia Regional Programme (SEARP). Co-chaired by Malaysia and New Zealand, the GRPN serves as a key platform for ASEAN Member States (AMS) and OECD countries to collaborate on regulatory reform, fostering knowledge exchange and supporting capacity building. The network promotes the implementation of Good Regulatory Practices (GRP), ensuring high-quality regulations and coherence, aligned with the ASEAN Economic Community (AEC) Blueprint 2025's objective of effective, efficient, and responsive regulations. ii) The 9th GRPN meeting, to be held on November 28, 2024, in Jakarta, Indonesia, aims to build future-ready regulatory frameworks amidst rapid technological advancements and global challenges. Key objectives include: a. Building Future-Ready Regulations: The meeting will explore how AMS and OECD countries can develop agile and adaptable regulations, particularly in the digital era. b. Enhancing Capacity for GRP: Continuing its mission, the GRPN will assist AMS in strengthening regulatory practices and coherence through knowledge partnerships and capacity-building initiatives. c. Promoting Digital Integration: Discussions will focus on how digital tools can streamline regulatory processes and enhance economic integration within ASEAN. iii) The GRPN assists AMS in addressing diverse development needs through regulatory reform initiatives, drawing on partnerships with organizations like the OECD and ERIA. Seven successful meetings have already been held to date. iv) MPC would also take the opportunity to: a. Courtesy Visit to Indonesian Regulatory Agency: While attending the meeting, MPC plans to conduct a courtesy visit to the relevant Indonesian agency to discuss regulatory reform initiatives. This visit will enhance bilateral cooperation and provide a valuable opportunity for Malaysia

	to learn from Indonesia's experiences and approaches to regulatory reform, further strengthening regional collaboration. b. Networking with UK OPSS for Future Collaboration: MPC aims to engage in networking discussions with the UK Office for Product Safety and Standards (OPSS) during the event. This interaction will explore opportunities for future collaboration, particularly in areas related to regulatory standards and innovation, thereby enhancing Malaysia's regulatory capabilities and ensuring alignment with international best practices. v) The proposed list of participants: - En.
