### **APO Membership Contributions for 2022**

At the 62nd session of the APO Governing Body held on 8 June 2020, the Directors decided that the total APO membership contribution for the 2021–2022 biennium would remain the same as previously at USD11,986,035. The formula for apportioning this amount was also unchanged. Based on the agreed total amount and continuing formula, the applicable amount for each member country's contribution for FY2022 has been computed and is shown in the attached table as confirmed by the 63rd session of the APO Governing Body held on 8 and 9 June 2021.
